

Progress Through Partnership

January 2024

Summary of the report on the 'East Plus' partnership between SEGRO and GLA Land and Property, by Gerald Eve LLP.

Established in 2016, **East Plus** is a collaboration between SEGRO and GLA Land and Property Limited. Its aim is to revitalise 86 acres of industrial land across the London boroughs of Newham, Havering, and Barking and Dagenham.

Beyond physical site delivery, East Plus has broader regeneration goals including upskilling the workforce, inspiring younger generations, and supporting community projects.

Originally envisioned as a 10-year project (extendable to 15), a mid-point review has been conducted to gather feedback, shape future stages, and serve as a guide for others looking to regenerate similar underutilised land.

Scale is an enabler

The 86-acre scale has played a big part in the Partnership's success.
